

Over the years, we've managed to improve our fishing techniques and constantly contribute to the provision of freshfish on the Romanian market. We are proud to produceour own fishing tools, using not only traditional methods, but also complying with all the requirements and standards of the European legislation.

We strongly believe in keeping the craft authentic, protecting th entire marine ecosystem, which forms the basis of our planet's food supply.

Our efforts brought us a noticeable place in Romania, the actual capturing the turbot, a great species on the fish market. Starting from my desire to share the taste and the fishing tradition with my family aside, together we opened "Vadu Pescarilor", a fishing cuisine place, where the fresh fish is prepared with authentic local ingredients. It's about the fish soup, the fried or grilled fish, each and every dish represents the sea itself, and also our local traditions.

We are keeping the tradition alive, cooking the mullet, enjoying the blueish, mackerel or the anchovies, within every dish. hortly after, "Vadu Pescarilor" has become a perfect spot for active partnerships and cooperations meant to sustain the preservation and durable development of the marine resources. We've accomplished partnerships and supported scientific research projects and activities within the fish farming sector, along with the "Grigore Antipa" National Institute of Marine Research and Development, the Aquatic Ecology Institute of research, development, fishing and aquaculture of Galati. We endorsed the sustenable fishing in partnership with the non guvernamental organisation General Association of Hunters and Fishermen in Romanian. We also supported the sustenable sport fishing, keeping the marine ecosystem well balanced. Thru our programme, the amateur fishermen have the opportunity to experience the emotions and the challenges of an authentic fishing, under the eye of the specialists, in the protected area of the Danube Delta Biosphere Reservation. The "Vadu Pescarilor" team together with the partners from the sport fishing organisation, offer support and guidelines using fishing techniques and understanding the local ecosystems, and the impact among all fish species. This experience offers a great respect lesson for the environment and pure joy for each capture, either small or big, giving the fact that many fishes are released, contributing to the local biodiversity health.
